THE MMRF LONGITUDINAL STUDY (COMPASS) WAS STARTED IN 2011 AND COMPLETED ENROLLMENT IN 2015. MMRF IS THE SPONSOR OF A PERSONALIZED MEDICINE INITIATIVE IN WHICH UP TO 1000 NEWLY DIAGNOSED PATIENTS WILL BE ENROLLED THROUGH SEVERAL SITES (I.E., HOSPITALS, ACADEMIC MEDICAL CENTERS AND OTHER COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTERS) ACROSS THE COUNTRY. NO EXPERIMENTAL DRUG IS TESTED IN THE STUDY. RATHER BLOOD AND BONE MARROW SAMPLES ARE TAKEN FROM THE PATIENTS AT EACH RELAPSE OVER THE COURSE OF THEIR TREATMENT.
